Fire Extinguishers & Blankets



Fire extinguishers and fire blankets are aimed at extinguishing small fires or containing a fire while an area is being evacuated. Under the Building Code of Australian WHS legislation and regulations all commercial buildings and work places (including vehicles) are required to have fire extinguishers. Fire blankets are generally required within kitchen areas with the risk of stove top fires.
